### **Program Legislative Overview**

#### Ferry Boat Discretionary (FBD) Program

- Program created in Section 1064 of the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA)
- 23 U.S.C. 129(c) and 147 (as in effect prior to MAP-21)
- Discretionary awards FY1992-2012

#### Ferry Boat Program (FBP)

- Program defined in Section 1121 of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21)
- Continued in the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST)
   Act
- 23 U.S.C. 129(c) and 147
- Formula distribution FY2013-2018






# **FBD Funds**

### **Program Overview**

- FBD Funds provided for the construction of ferry boats and ferry terminal facilities in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 129(c)
- Funds are available until expended, within the original scope of the congressionally-designated or competitive award
- Federal Share 80%





### Requesting Allocation

#### Before requesting allocation of FBD Funds:

- Confirm unallocated balance available
- Verify that the project is ready to obligate the funds
- Verify that the proposed project is within the original scope of the award

#### To request allocation of available funds:

- Division emails allocation request to program manager
  - Identifies awarded FBD project
  - Includes a statement that the division has verified that the proposed project falls within the original scope of the FBD award






# **FBP Funds**

### **FBP Overview**

- FBP funds provided for construction of ferry boats, ferry terminals, and ferry maintenance facilities ferry terminal facilities in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 129(c) and 147
- Funds are available until expended, subject to redistribution
- Federal Share 80%





### Ferry Boat Operator Eligibility

- FBP funds are made available to eligible entities in the United States and its territories
- Eligible entities are determined in accordance with 23 U.S.C. 129(c). An eligible project and entity must meet all the following conditions:
  - 1. It is not feasible to build a bridge, tunnel, combination thereof, or other normal highway structure in lieu of the use of such ferry.
  - 2. The operation of the ferry shall be on a route classified as a public road within the State and that has not been designated as a route on the Interstate System. Included are ferry boats carrying cars and passengers and ferry boats carrying passengers only on a fixed route.
  - 3. The ferry boat or ferry terminal facility using Federal funds shall be **publicly owned or operated**, or majority publicly owned (51 percent) if the Secretary determines that the facility provides substantial public benefits.



### Ferry Boat Operator Eligibility

- 4. The operating authority and the amount of fares charged for passage on such ferry shall be under the control of the State or other public entity, and all revenues derived shall be applied to actual and necessary costs of operation, maintenance, and repair, debt service, negotiated management fees, and, in the case of a privately operated toll ferry, for a reasonable rate of return.
- 5. The ferry may be operated only within a State (including the islands which comprise the State of Hawaii and the islands which comprise any territory of the United States) or between adjoining States or between a point in a State and a point in the Dominion of Canada. Except with respect to operations between the islands which comprise the State of Hawaii, operations between the islands which comprise any territory of the United States, operations between a point in a State and a point in the Dominion of Canada, and operations between any two points in Alaska and between Alaska and Washington, including stops at appropriate points in the Dominion of Canada, no part of such ferry operation shall be in any foreign or international waters.

#### **Formula Distribution Data**

- A state/territory with an eligible entity that meets program requirements will receive at least \$100,000 for the fiscal year, per 23 U.S.C. 147(f)
- Data to determine distribution amounts from biennial census data, collected by the Bureau of Transportation Statistics (BTS)
- Distribution formula:
  - Number of ferry passengers (35%)
  - Number of vehicles carried (35%)
  - Total route nautical miles (30%)



### **Fund Redistribution**

- FBP Funds remain available until expended
- Eligible entities lose ability to use funds that remain unobligated three fiscal years following fiscal year of distribution
- Funds redistributed nationwide to eligible entities

### FBP - Requesting Allocation

#### Before requesting allocation of FBP Funds:

- Verify that the project is ready to obligate the funds
- Confirm that the ferry service is an eligible operator
- Confirm that the proposed project is eligible for FBP Funds

#### To request allocation of FBP distributed funds:

- Division emails allocation request to program manager
  - Identifies awarded FBP operator and fiscal year
  - Include a statement confirming that the project is ready to be obligated
  - Include a statement that the division confirmed that the ferry service and project are eligible for FBP funds
