


- ▶ 2000 B.C. Chamorros were originally from Southeast Asia.
- Spanish explorer Ferdinand Magellan in 1521 The islands were named after Queen Maria Ana of Spain.
- Led by Chief Aghurubw and Chief Nguschul of the Caroline Islands, the settlement of the Carolinians in The Marianas began in 1815.


#### War and Possession

- Germany purchased The Marianas from Spain in 1899-1914
- Japan received the islands by the terms of the Treaty of Versailles in 1919, and then later, as a mandate under the League of Nations in 1920.
- U.S. forces gained control of The Marianas in July 1944. In 1947, United Nations strategic trusteeship known as the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands with the U.S. as the administering authority.
- Self-governing commonwealth in January 1978. In November 1986, U.S. citizenship was conferred upon the people of The Marianas.






