## Establishing a White House Working Group on Puerto Rico

- In July 2022, the White House <u>hosted</u> the inaugural meeting of the White House Working Group on Puerto Rico, a cabinet-level task force chaired by the Domestic Policy Advisor, the National Economic Advisor, and the Director of Intergovernmental Affairs.
- The task force reports directly to the President and is focused on providing Puerto Rico with the resources and technical assistance it needs to recover and prosper.
- Since the inaugural meeting, agencies have been consulting with stakeholders and devising strategies to support the island's economic development and recovery efforts, promote workforce and educational opportunities, and invest in greater transparency and governance efforts.

# Policy Deliverables for Puerto Rico Economic Dialogue



Administration

- The Department of Transportation will strengthen technical assistance and increase DOT personnel and resources to enhance Puerto Rico's administrative capacity so that federal funds can efficiently move from allocation to obligation to expenditure.
- The Department of Transportation will pursue a strategic partnerships to help facilitate major infrastructure projects and innovative financing opportunities for a network of priority infrastructure improvements on the island.
- The Department of Transportation will pursue contracting options department-wide on language translation services so that stakeholders (project sponsors, grant recipients, agency officials, and others) are better supported in seeking DOT grant and formula funding program opportunities in a timely manner.
