TTIP Call for Projects

- Priority is based upon the 10-year Highway Master Plan
- Proposed projects by the general public, stakeholders and/or government officials can be submitted to DPW for consideration that may be included in development of TTIP

Development of draft TTIP by TART

- Prioritize projects
- Schedule projects in their phases by Fiscal Year
- Evaluate if plan is fiscally constrained
- Include Federal Transit Authority's Budget

TART submits draft TTIP to FHWA

- FHWA Hawaii Division will review and make recommendations on TART's draft TTIP

TART approves final draft TTIP before advertising for public review

- TART will vote on draft five (5) voting-members - majority rules

30-day public review for comment of final draft TTIP

- Draft is released thru newspaper media for public comment
- Emailed to the Governor & Local Officials
- Emailed to Local Transit Authorities & other Local Agencies

Final signatures for approval of TTIP

- DPW Secretary
- Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority
- FTA
- FHWA

TTIP document finalized, reproduced for distribution

- TTIP distributed to the Governor, Local Officials & Local Agencies



TTIP becomes effective



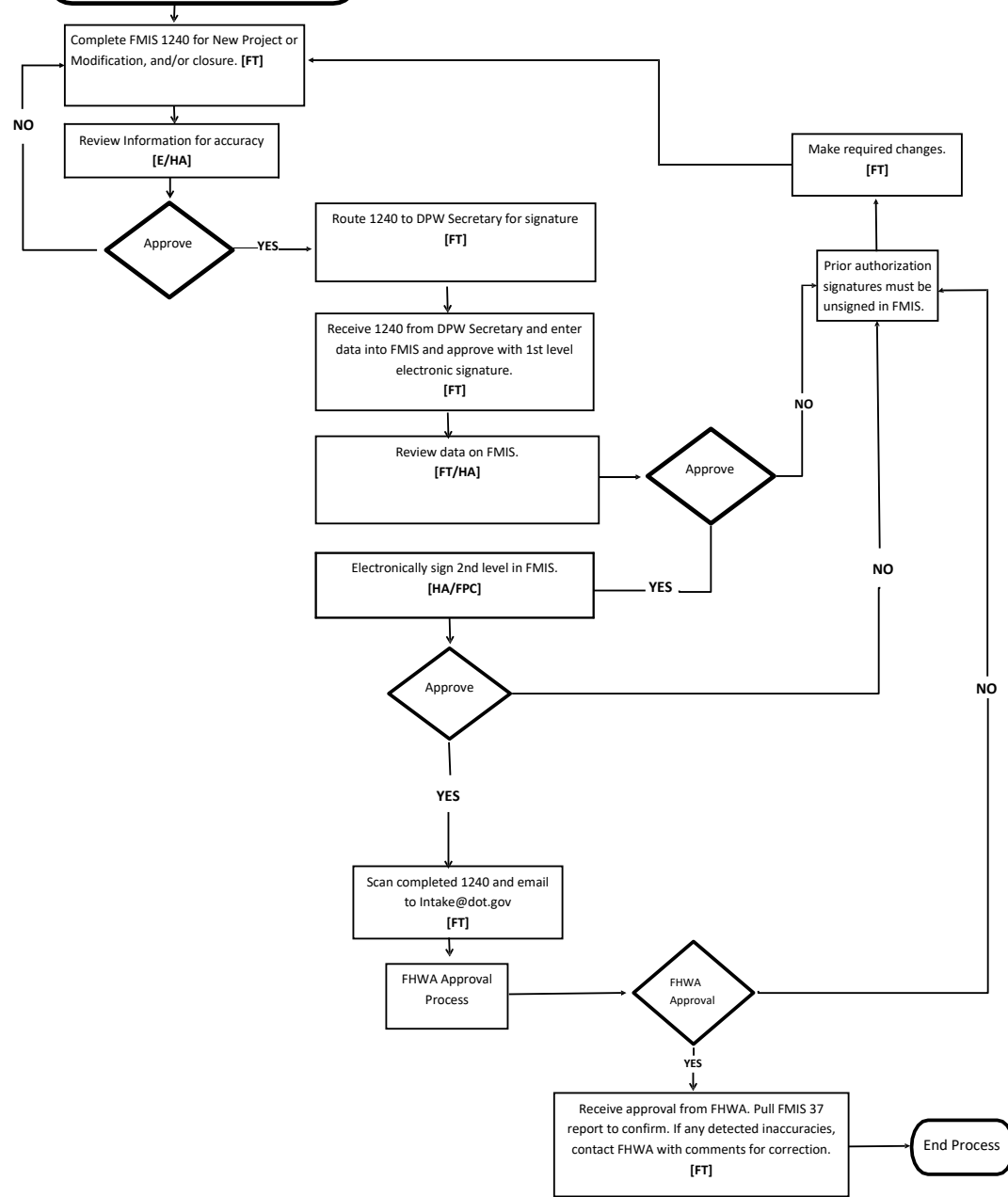
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
CNMI TTIP Project Developed:

- B. Construction Phase has an approved PS&E & environmental documents. [FT/E/HA]

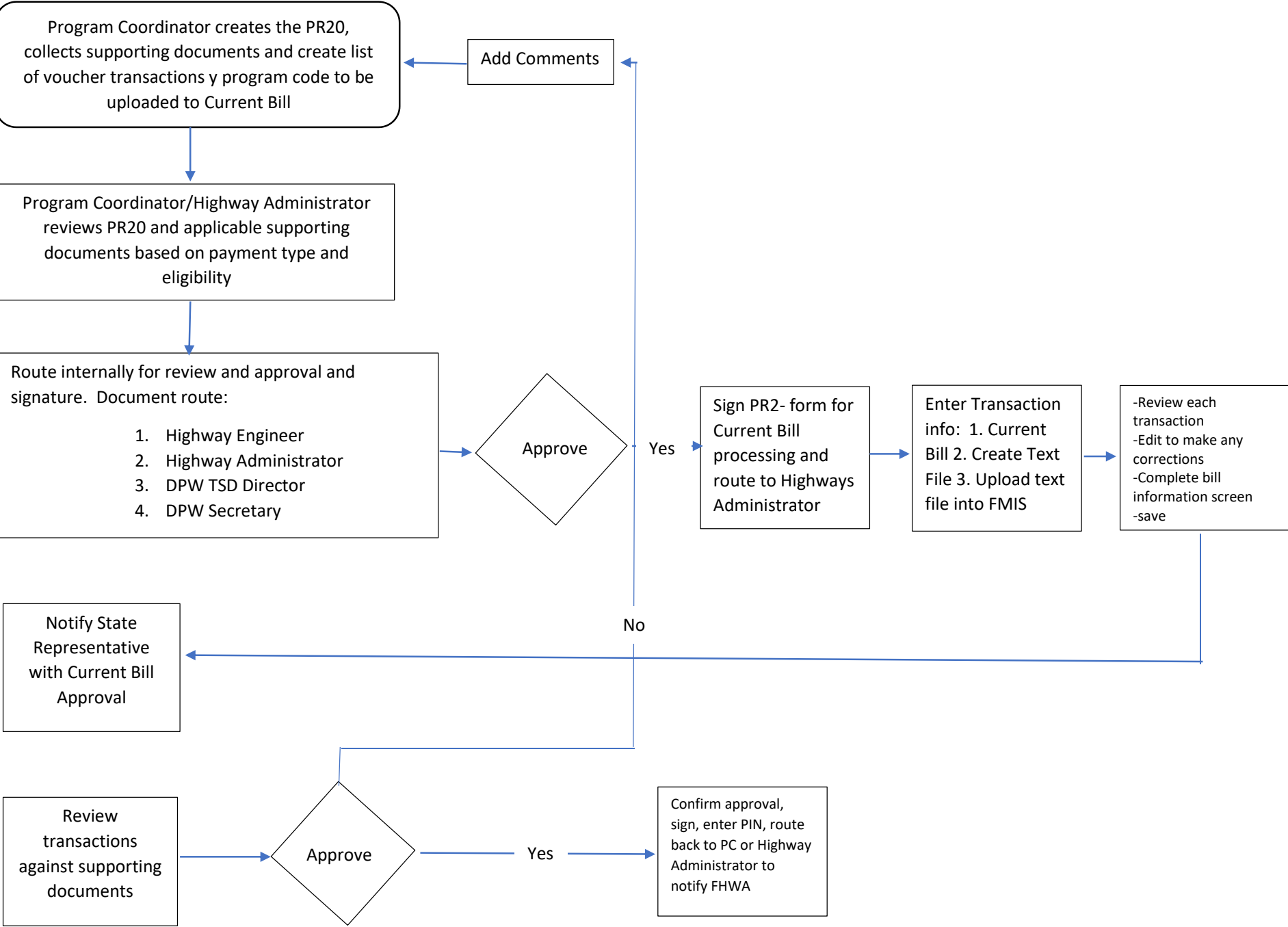
